OUR FESTIVE OPERATING CALENDAR (2025 - 2026)

Up to Wed 24 Dec 2025 – Deliveries as normal (if Wednesday is your usual delivery day)

Thu 25 Dec 2025 (Christmas Day) - Closed

Fri 26 Dec 2025 (Boxing Day) - Closed

Mon 29 Dec 2025 - Deliveries on designated routes for pre-placed orders

Tue 30 Dec 2025 - Normal day

Wed 31 Dec 2025 (New Year's Eve) - Normal day

Thu 1 Jan 2026 (New Year's Day) - Closed

Fri 2 Jan 2026 - Open (for orders placed prior to Wed 31 Dec)

Tip: If your usual delivery day falls on one of our closed days, please pre-book an alternative slot from 1st November - so we can guarantee space on the vehicle

HOW TO SAIL THROUGH THE SEASON

Pre-book early (from 1 Nov):

Lock in your preferred dates in December & early January.

Order a little ahead:

Build in extra cover on your top sellers (milk, cream, oils, chips, breads, desserts, soft drinks, beer/wine, disposables).

Check your normal cut-off times:

They still apply.

Tell us your big dates:

Parties, preorders, event menus share the peaks so we can plan vehicle space and stock.

Keep a back-up plan:

Consider a small top-up order for the first week of January to ease the New Year rush.
